

## **Petition Against Means-Testing the Seniors Drug Plan**

*To the Honourable Legislative Assembly of Saskatchewan in legislature assembled:*

*The petition of the undersigned citizens of the Province of Saskatchewan humbly showeth:*

That in March of 2007, the NDP Government introduced a Seniors' Drug Plan, which capped the cost of prescription drugs for all seniors at \$15 per prescription;

That starting July 1, 2008 the Saskatchewan Party will take away prescription drug benefits from thousands of Saskatchewan seniors;

That in February of 2008 the Saskatchewan Party Government announced all seniors would be forced to apply to keep their benefits under the Seniors Drug Plan;
